

PASTORAL MESSAGE

It is Time (Καιρός) for the Lord to Act!

What creature walks on four legs in the morning, two in the afternoon, and three in the evening? This is the renown riddle posed to Oedipus by the Sphinx in Greek mythology, and he answered correctly: in the morning of life, a human crawls on all fours as a baby. In the afternoon, when they have grown, they walk on two legs. And in the evening, during old age, they use a cane or walking stick as a third leg to support themselves.

While I have reached the evening of my life, I am happy to say I still don't need a cane and I also don't think of myself as old, despite the fact my successor as Proistemanos is half my age! But the riddle does highlight certain immutable facts of life, because indeed "time marches on." When asked what I'm planning to do in retirement, I respond by saying, "I'm not retiring but refocusing." Focusing on what? You know the adage, man proposes, but God disposes. This is true in every stage of our life, and as I recall the blessings of 37 years of ministry as an Orthodox Priest, I look forward with anticipation (and some trepidation) what God has in store for me and Presbytera Barbara. Many of you are familiar with the difference between chronos time and kairos time, the former we measure, the latter we experience. Regardless of our longevity, the goal of every disciple of Jesus is to live in the moment (kairos time), worshipping the Triune God in spirit and truth, and with unconditional love for our neighbor. This is what I hope and aspire to focus on with whatever time I have left in this life, that they may have my joy fulfilled in themselves. (John 17:13)

This is also what I truly wish for you, my beloved Church family of nineteen years. In addition to 1,000 Sunday Divine Liturgies, we have celebrated 453 baptisms, 200 weddings and 410 funerals together. You have shared our joy in marrying all of our children and the arrival of nine grandchildren. But get ready, because the best is yet to come!

But this is what was spoken by the prophet Joel: And it shall come to pass in the last days, says God, That I will pour out of My Spirit on all flesh; Your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, Your young men shall see visions, Your old men shall dream dreams. (Acts 2:16,17)

Beloved in Christ, as I hand off the baton to your next spiritual leader, I only ask that you pray for me to continue to dream dreams, especially if and when I will be walking on three legs.

In my tenure as Parish Council president, I have had the privilege of working alongside Father James, witnessing firsthand his unwavering commitment to our community. Even through the challenges of COVID, Father James kept our congregation connected, nurturing our faith and fellowship.

Our church has flourished under Father James' stewardship, marked by an increase in diversity and attendance across Sunday School, Philoptochos, and community events like the Greek Festival. His impact is immeasurable, from delivering over 1,200 Divine Liturgies to supporting families through baptisms, weddings, and funerals. Following his graduation from Holy Cross, Father James began his journey in the Church as a deacon in 1986, and was ordained into the priesthood in 1987 by Archbishop Iakovos. Alongside his wife, Presbytera Barbara, he has served with distinction in four parishes: Cathedral of the Annunciation in San Francisco, Church of the Resurrection in Castro Valley, Holy Trinity in Portland, and ultimately here at our Annunciation Church in Sacramento.

As we bid farewell to Father James, we celebrate his dedication and the indelible legacy he leaves behind. His service has been a testament to the power of faith and the strengthening of our Annunciation community.

I am wishing you all a joyful summer, filled with rest and time with family and friends. For those who are traveling, I pray for your safe travels. Please remember that, although many of our ministries take a break for the summer, church continues with regular services and community fellowship. I look forward to seeing you there! At the conclusion of summer, our ministries will resume with the Ecclesiastical New Year and our Ministries Kickoff on Sunday, September 8. 




